CHILD SAFETY SEATS SAVE LIVES
Properly installed seats reduce
the risk of injury in a crash:

71%
for infants

54%
for toddlers

- ✓ Avoid buying a used car seat or booster seat
- ✓ Use the correct seat for your child's age and size
- ✓ Secure the car seat so it moves no more than 1" side-to-side
- ✓ Car seats & boosters should only be installed in the back seat, using the center most position



SAFETY TIPS FOR EVERY AGE!

0-3

YEARS OLD

Keep your child rear-facing as long as possible. It's the best way to keep your child safe.

2-4

YEARS OLD

Once your child outgrows the rear-facing car seat, your child is ready for a forward-facing car seat.

4-8

YEARS OLD

Keep your child in a forward-facing car seat with a harness and tether until he or she reaches the top height or weight limit allowed by your car seat's manufacturer.

8+

YEARS OLD

Keep your child in a booster seat until he or she is big enough to fit in a seat belt properly. Your child should still ride in the back seat because it's safer there.
