
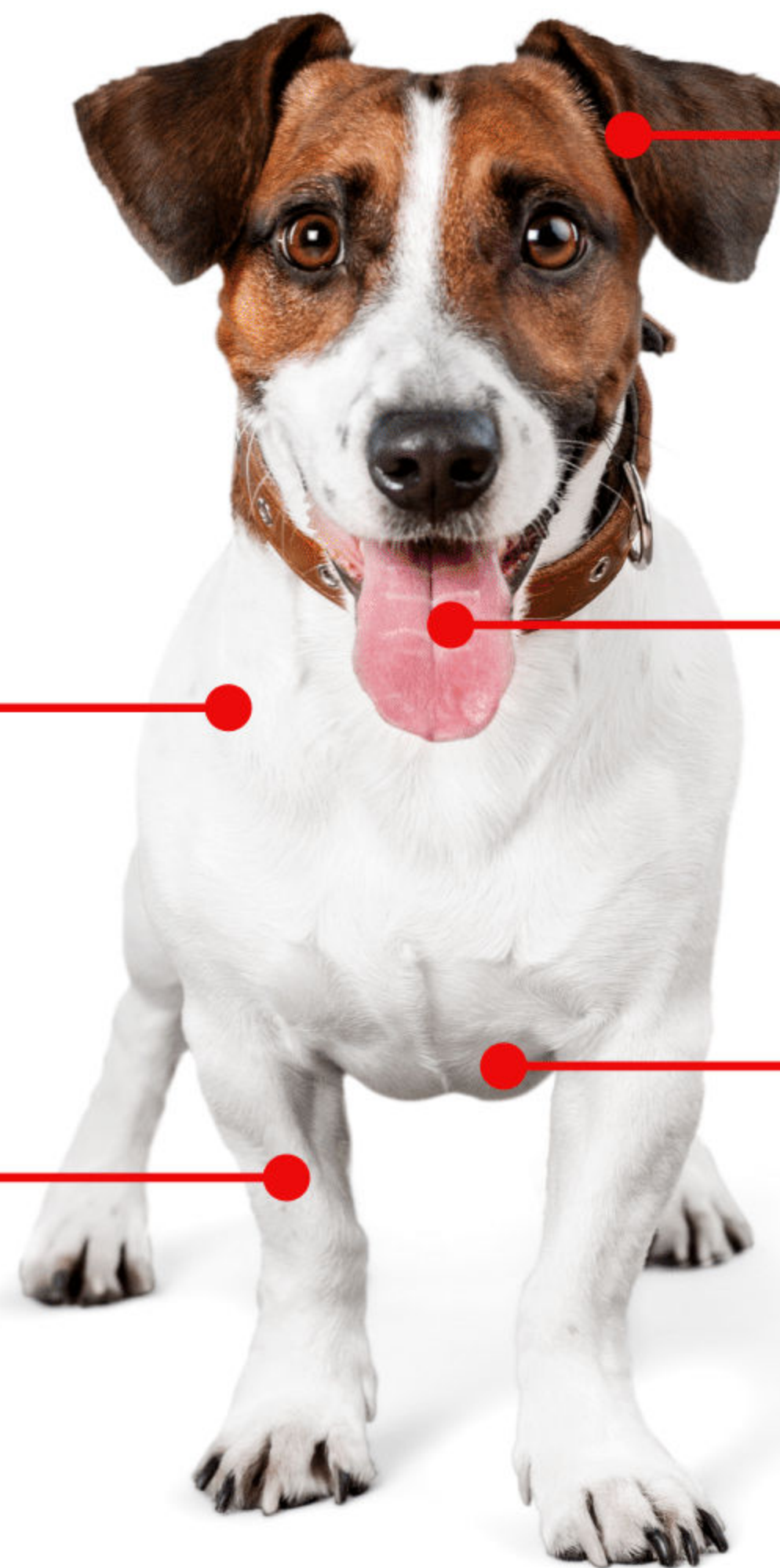


HEAT STROKE

KNOW THE SIGNS IN YOUR PET



Pets can suffer from a **heat stroke** just like humans. Exercise in high (80+) temperatures, lack of water, and being left in a hot vehicle can all cause a heat stroke. Overheating and heat strokes can cause irreversible **organ damage** and, in some cases, **death**. That is why it is important to know the signs and limit your pet's time outdoors.



HEAD

*Disoriented
Confused
Lethargic
Anxious*

MOUTH

*Dry mouth
Excessive panting
Bright red gums*

STOMACH

*Vomiting
Diarrhea
Dark urine
Loss of Appetite*

BODY

*Weakness
Racing heart
Seizures
Radiating heat*

LEGS

*Wobbly
Unsteady
Collapsing*

6 Steps to Prevent a Heat Stroke in Your Pet:

1. **Limit their time outdoors**
2. **Never leave them in a hot car**
3. **Give them water and shade**
4. **Restrict exercise**
5. **Stay off of asphalt**
6. **Don't get them shaved**
